



Anti-social Behaviour

The Tubbs Turf Management Committee is responsible for the management, maintenance and development of the Tubbs Turf Facilities in Kingswood.

Whilst we have adopted a Code of Conduct for those who make use of the facility, we recognize that there is always scope for users to ignore this Code which may result in Anti-social Behaviour.

In the event that you are, or have been, exposed to Anti-social Behaviour, and you wish to report this, if the behaviour is severe, we advise that you should contact the Police on 101.

If, however, the behaviour does not need to be dealt with immediately, then we advise that you contact the Neighbourhood Warden appointed by Stroud District Council. The Wardens work within the Stroud Community Safety Partnership, providing intelligence work on behalf of Stroud District Council as outlined in the 1998 Crime and Disorder Act. An important aspect of the warden's work is providing help and support in dealing with anti-social behaviour. They work closely with the police and, should they be unable to resolve a problem, would make them aware of the matter.

The current Neighbourhood Warden for the Kingswood Parish is Andy Beamish. Andy is aware that there have been recent incidents of Anti-social Behaviour on the courts at Tubbs and, as a consequence, the area is now being monitored.
