

Code of Conduct for use of the Facility

The Tubbs Turf facility is a significant sports and recreational amenity for Kingswood and the surrounding area. It is run on a daily basis by a group of local volunteers (the "Stewards") and it is managed and maintained by an organising committee (also volunteers).

Unlike most sports facilities, it is surrounded on 3 sides by private housing and on 2 sides by passing pedestrians of all ages. It is therefore important that users of Tubbs Turf respect this situation and show due consideration to neighbours and passing pedestrians. It is also essential that users help maintain the facility in good, safe condition.

For these reasons the following "Code of Conduct" applies to all those using the Tubbs Turf facilities:

- 1. Note that opening times are 09:00 until sunset or 21:00, whichever is earlier. Access is prohibited at any other time.
- 2. The lower Tennis Court is for Tubbs Turf members use only.
- The top Multi-Sport Court is open to all except when it has been booked by Tubbs
 Turf Members. At other times, priority should be given to Kingswood children of
 school age.
- 4. All users should respect other users, neighbours and Tubbs Turf Stewards.
- 5. Footballs used on the top court should be limited to lightweight, size 3 balls.
- 6. No foul or abusive language, or anti-social behaviour is tolerated.
- 7. Music or sound systems are strictly prohibited.
- 8. Skate boards, bicycles, or scooters are not allowed on the courts.
- No one should climb on boundary walls or fences or on the court fencing under any circumstance.
- 10. All litter should be placed in one of the four bins provided or the recycling box at the pavilion, as appropriate.
